Dear Minister / *Parliamentary Secretary*

You may be aware that early in 2010 the Crime and Misconduct Commission, following its report of an investigation into the conduct of a former Director-General of the Department of Employment and Training, Scott Flavell, recommended that all Departments should keep a register of contacts with lobbyists.

It developed a computerised pro-forma register, with drop down menus, to assist staff in maintaining a register and to provide uniformity of record-keeping.

Later the CMC recommended to all local governments in Queensland that they should each maintain a similar (or identical) register of contact between local government councillors and the senior employees of councils with lobbyists.

Government Owned Corporations were also advised to maintain similar registers.

Ministers and their offices are, like all public sector agencies, required by the *Public Records Act 2002* to keep "full and accurate" records of their activities. This extends to creating and retaining records of all contact by government representatives with all entities seeking to influence government decision-making whether the lobbyist is registered or not. (Principle 7 of Information Standard 40)

The Queensland State Archivist and I are currently developing a joint advice on record-keeping requirements of contact between government representatives (including Ministers and their staff) and lobbyists, regardless of whether the lobbyist is registered or not. This advice will cover the making of records of meetings, telephone conversations, emails and any other business activities.


In the meantime it is desirable that Ministers' offices should keep records based on the CMC module. This would be available from your own Department, or from the CMC.

The *Integrity Act 2009*, in section 72A, provides for the disclosure to the Integrity Commissioner of information about contact between a government representative and a registered lobbyist, notwithstanding the provisions of the *Information Privacy Act 2009*, though the Integrity Commissioner may not disclose personal information that is provided.

I am currently obtaining a copy of the records of contact with lobbyists of Departments and local governments for the month of June.

I propose to seek a copy of records kept by all Ministerial offices of such contacts for the month of September 2011.

Yes, under the Integrity Act, Government representatives – Ministers and their offices, public servants and local governments are required to keep records of any contact they have with registered and unregistered lobbyists. Most departments maintain a pro-forma form which lists whether the contact was made in person, by phone, or email etc and lists the outcome of the contact i.e. whether or not further action/contact was undertaken.

At various stages throughout the year, the Commissioner requests all government departments, Ministers and local governments to provide him with samples of the contact registers for certain months in order to help gauge the effectiveness of the lobbying provisions in the Act.

In order to check the accuracy of the required government record keeping, this time the Commissioner is seeking the



cooperation of lobbyists to provide him with some basic information about the number of contacts lobbyists have had with Ministers and departments etc.
