1.1 Electoral Commissioner

- Release of the Woods Report on sports' integrity across the nation.

1.3 Ombudsman

- Ombudsman has provided a submission to Parliamentary Transport and Public Works Committee inquiry into towing on toll roads.

1.4 Commission Chief Executive, Public Service Commission

- Advance in Queensland Priorities Work.
- Ministerial of Oversight Group (MOOG) established.
- The 'Working for Queensland Survey' to be rolled out next week.

1.5 Chair, Crime and Corruption Commission

- Ipswich Criminal Investigation and public report finalised.

- Department of Health commissioned a review into the provision of medical services to prisons.
- Finalised tour of indigenous communities.
- Sharon Cowden appointed as Assistant Commissioner, Queensland Police, Ethical Standards Command.

- Right to Information Day is 28 September 2018.
- Co-host delivery of the *The Solomon Lecture* on 24 September 2018.
- Next year is the tenth anniversary of *Right to Information Act 2009* and *Information Privacy Act 2009*.
- Louisa Lynch appointed Right to Information Commissioner.
